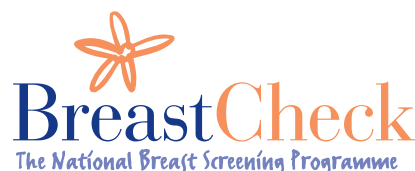


We're expanding across Ireland - Will you join us?



BreastCheck, the National Breast Screening Programme, is a government-funded service in Ireland offering free breast screening to women aged 50–64. In preparation for national expansion, BreastCheck is seeking candidates for the following posts:

Radiography Services Manager, Southern area – (Ref SMAY07)

The post will be based in the Southern unit, located at the South Infirmary - Victoria University Hospital, Cork. The Radiography Services Manager will report to the Clinical Director of the Unit and will provide strategic and clinical leadership.

The successful candidate will take a lead role in provision of mammography, radiographic quality assurance and oversee ongoing development of radiographer capacity and development, recruitment and training within the unit.

The ideal candidate will have a:

- Recognised radiography qualification
- Minimum of seven years radiography experience
- Post-Graduate qualification in mammography
- Substantial management experience, together with excellent interpersonal and communication skills
- A car owner is essential

Remuneration for this post is based on The Department of Health and Children pay scale for Radiography Services Manager 1.

Radiographers and Mammographers – (Ref S&WMAY07)

In preparation for national expansion of the service, BreastCheck has vacancies for Radiographers across Ireland. These jobs are on a full-time and part-time basis.

Minimum requirements for candidates:

- Recognised Radiography Qualification
- Minimum of one year of radiography experience
- Certificate of competence in mammography - not essential as training is provided at BreastCheck's National Radiography Training Centre
- A car owner is essential

We offer competitive packages including travel (across Ireland) and we would welcome the opportunity to discuss the choices available to you. Remuneration is based on The Department of Health and Children pay scale for Senior Radiographers.
