**3-day Residential Programme**

The ASRT introduced the Leadership Academy for Educators (LAE) in 2003 and, following its success, have determined to run this programme annually.

The opportunity consists of a 3 day residential programme, held in Albuquerque, for approximately 20 selected (by competitive application) educators who are at or near the beginning of their career in radiography education. It provides significant development and mentorship for those selected to participate.

In 2007, the ASRT is reserving one place for a UK candidate. The ASRT kindly provides accommodation and all LAE materials for the successful awardee. The Society and College of Radiographers pays the awardee's travel costs to a maximum of £500.00.

**Criteria of application for this Award**

Applicants must submit a written 1000 word statement (mindful of the criteria given in Appendix 1) explaining why they feel they would benefit from the Award, how they would disseminate their experiences and learning locally and nationally, and what they might hope to do as a result of the experience. You will also be prepared to write a report for consideration by the SCoR Research Group and a news item for Synergy News.

## Appendix 1

### Society and College of Radiographers Criteria for the ASRT Leadership Academy for Educators award

#### You must:

- Be a member of the Society and College of Radiographers (SCoR)
- Be in a post with experience of learning, teaching and assessment in a radiography pre-registration setting/course environment. Normally it would be expected that your experience of education would be a minimum of one year and no more than five years. Experience in education may include clinical education roles as well as roles in education institutions.
- Hold a formal contractual arrangement with an HEI (either substantive or honorary) that is engaged in delivering radiography education.
- If successful, submit a written report for publication in Synergy News and for the SCoR Research group, and be prepared to speak about their experiences. In particular this should identify your contribution to professional clinical/academic knowledge as a result of taking this opportunity.
- Provide a supporting statement from your Head of Department/ Academic Professional Lead to ensure that your application is supported by your institution/employer.
- Be prepared to act as an ambassador for the professional body. As such you will be required to sign and adhere to the terms of reference for representing SCoR.
- Hold, or demonstrate the evidence that you will complete, an MSc or PGD award in a relevant subject (e.g. science, theory, management, practice or education relevant to radiography)

- One electronic copy of your completed application form to Yvonne Reihill by noon on January 17<sup>th</sup> 2007. **Additionally you must submit a hard copy during the week leading up to February 28<sup>th</sup>.**
